


2018 - 2019 - 5 Pupils - 2 pupils went to Grammar School

- 2 pupils continued in Private Education
- 1 pupil family moved abroad





In 2019 the decision was made to stop the sitting of formal SATS papers as the timings of these did not facilitate better outcomes for the students and in discussion with the local schools they do not use the results, as they do their own CAT tests and setting on admission. Testing still takes place in the Summer term using the SATS papers to ensure teacher assessments are accurate.



- 1 pupil continued in Private Education (family moved out of the area)


